Hunslet RLFC is a semi - professional rugby league club based in South Leeds. The Club currently play in League 1, the third tier of the professional game. The Club is the only wholly supporter owned professional team in the sport and is run largely by a volunteer workforce. Due to current post holder leaving to study for a Masters Degree the club is looking to appoint a Lead Therapist ahead of the 2022 season, the role is a paid, part-time position. This is an exciting opportunity for the right individual to work with a progressive organisation.

The role will require attendance at training sessions (currently Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday evenings) and matchdays usually Sundays. Managing a small team of student therapists in assessing and treating sporting injuries, pre match/training rub downs and strapping. A strong communicator is required to communicate with club officials, players and the multidisciplinary team effectively.

Role requirements

- Assess and treat a variety of sporting injuries
- Managing pitch side treatment, including concussion and trauma
- Communicate with players and staff appropriately
- Document treatment in line with professional requirements
- Manage a small team of student therapists

Essential criteria

- BSc (hons) Physiotherapy/Sports Therapy/Sports Rehabilitation
- Appropriate governing/professional body membership CSP/SST/BASRAT
- Strong communicator
- IMMOFP Qualification
- Personal Professional Indemnity Insurance
- Experience in semi-professional sport, ideally Rugby League
- Evidence based approach to managing sporting injuries

Desirable criteria

- Post graduate sports medicine qualification
- Suturing qualification
- Experience leading a small team
- Post graduate S&C or exercise therapy qualification
